We're so glad you're here!





Reflect on the Word

First Reading: Ecclesiastes speaks of "vanity" in the sense of emptiness or futility, such as those who seek to build their legacy or those who suffer with a restless heart. How are you able to remain focused on the important things in your life?

Second Reading: Paul teaches the Colossians that the key to focusing on "what is above, not on what is on earth" is to live a moral and upright life, grounded in your faith in Christ. Who do you know who does this well?

Gospel: Jesus tells the parable of the rich fool in response to a question about inheritance, warning the crowd about over dependence on possessions. How do you balance your material needs with "what matters to God?"

Ashley's Experience in RCIA

What brought you to RCIA?

My desire to better understand the Catholic faith is ultimately what brought me to RCIA. I grew up in the Methodist church and my husband, Kris, grew up Catholic. When we got married, we decided that we would attend and raise our children in the Methodist church. I had Catholic roots on both sides of my family, who had subsequently left the church due to bad experiences and in turn left me with a very negative connotation towards the church. For the last 10 years, we have raised our family in the Methodist church and have been very involved. When COVID hit in 2020, the church we were attending shutdown for an entire year. A whole year of not attending church left my spiritual tank feeling very empty and it unearthed a lot of other doubts and disagreements I had towards the Methodist church. One day, I told Kris that I couldn't take another Sunday of no church. He suggested we head 5 mins down the street and try out Sacred Heart and I guess you could say the rest was history. We started attending in spring of 2021 and during the summer I heard the announcement about RCIA. Much to his surprise, I told Kris that I would like to attend to learn more about the faith and he encouraged me to go for it.



What was your experience through this year's RCIA process?

I met with Char before the first RCIA class started and really enjoyed my time with her. She put my mind at ease that having been raised a believer, my faith was respected and that nobody was going to pressure me into converting. Going into RCIA my pride caused me to be somewhat guarded. I had spent many years saying I would NEVER convert and here I was considering doing exactly that. The first class we introduced ourselves and talked about some of our biggest questions or “hang ups” with the Catholic Church. Two things that stood out to me most were that there were so many former Methodists that were converts and now sponsors and that upon talking to them they initially had all the same concerns/misconceptions that I did. These conversations helped me to swallow my pride, let my guard down, and open my heart to what the Lord had in store for me. I really enjoyed the RCIA process as a whole. The leaders and sponsors were fantastic, the way the material was presented was very relatable and easy to understand, and there was priority given to making sure our every last question was answered thoroughly.

What was your biggest surprise/Aha moment about the Catholic Church?

There were a lot of aha moments for me. One of the biggest things that had previously turned me off about the Catholic Church in the past was I never felt welcome. I felt like the church lacked fellow-

ship and that there was no sense of community. After going through RCIA and learning about the traditions of the church, I realized that I was mistaking reverence for rudeness-the reason nobody was chatting before mass is because they were being reverent, not because I wasn't welcome or they were being rude. I never imagined I would feel so at peace and find comfort in the mass, but again-once I truly understood what was going on my mind was changed. I could go on and on, but the last thing I will share is I never imagined I could feel so at peace about death. The way Deacon Nicholas and Char explained dying and heaven was more informative than anything I had ever heard. I walked away at peace.

What would you say to someone who is considering joining or returning to the Catholic faith through the RCIA process?

I would absolutely encourage them to go through the process. I would tell them that they are entering a judgement free zone, filled with people who are passionate about their faith and have been praying for them long before they ever considered coming to RCIA. I would tell them to go in with an open mind and try to let their guard down. I would also tell them to be prepared to step out of their comfort zone and experience the Holy Spirit in ways they never imagined.

Saint of the Week, St. Alphonsus Liguori *Feast Day is August 1*



Saint Alphonsus was born into a well-respected family in 1696, in Marianella, in the Kingdom of Naples. He received an exceptional education through private tutors and was conferred degrees in civil and canon law at 16. He practiced law for 8 years before he turned to the Church. He was ordained a priest in 1726.

Saint Alphonsus traveled for 26 years in Kingdom of Naples preaching. His style of ministry was called “mission among the people,” he and a group of priests or lay brothers would go to rural areas, staying for a time to teach, preach, and pray with the people there. Saint Alphonsus was a brilliant preacher, he was able to connect with ordinary people and his teaching and sermons were marked by his compassion. In a time of restrictive Church rule, where fear of God was truly fear, Saint Alphonsus taught about God's redeeming love. He also had a special devotion to Mary, praying to her for intercession and including devotions to her in his teaching. He wrote extensively, more than 100 books which have been through thousands of editions. His books are still available today and have been translated into more than 60 languages. In 1762 Saint Alphonsus was made a bishop by Pope Clement XIII, however, he was eventually allowed to resign his post because of his ill health. He was paralyzed for a time from rheumatic fever in 1775, and had rheumatism so severe it was deforming, bending his head so far forward that his chin rested on his chest. He died peacefully at the age of 90 in 1787. He was canonized in 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI.


