

SURRENDERING

Fr. Joseph Asante Sunday Reflection



he Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, celebrated on the final Sunday of the liturgical year (November 23 in 2025), is a powerful reminder that Christ's kingship is unlike any earthly rule. Instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925, this feast was a response to growing secularism and nationalism, emphasizing that Christ must reign in our hearts, homes, and societies.

Gospel Focus: Luke 23:35-43

This year's Gospel reading places us at Calvary, where Jesus is crucified between two criminals. One mocks Him, but the other—often called the "Good Thief"—makes a humble plea: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." Jesus replies, "Today you will be with me in paradise".

This moment reveals the true nature of Christ's kingship:

- · Merciful: He forgives even in His final moments.
- · Accessible: His kingdom is open to the repentant, no matter their past.
- · Self-giving: His throne is the cross, and His crown is of thorns.

Reflection Themes

- A Kingdom of Love, Not Power: Christ's rule is not about domination but about serving others with compassion and humility.
- Hope in Suffering: Even in pain, Jesus offers hope. The Good Thief's story reminds us that it's never too late to turn to Christ.
- End of the Liturgical Year: This feast closes the Church year, inviting us to reflect on where Christ stands in our lives and how we've lived His teachings.

A Personal Challenge

Ask yourself:

- · Do I recognize Christ as King in my daily decisions?
- Do I serve others as He did?
- Am I building His kingdom of justice, peace, and mercy?

As we prepare to enter Advent, the Solemnity of Christ the King calls us to renew our allegiance to Jesus—not just with words, but with lives shaped by His example. This feast is a powerful invitation to recommit our lives to Christ's reign, not just in church, but in our homes, workplaces, and communities.

In Quarter 4 of 2025, we needed \$79,710.06 per week for our operating budget.




